**[PROPOSED] ORDER GRANTING
MOTION FOR PRELIMINARY
APPROVAL OF CLASS ACTION
SETTLEMENT**

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1 The Court, having read the papers filed regarding Plaintiff's unopposed Motion for
2 Preliminary Approval of Class and Representative Action Settlement, and having heard argument
3 regarding the Motion, hereby finds and ORDERS as follows:

4 1. The Joint Stipulation of Settlement and Release of Claims ("Settlement
5 Agreement") attached as Exhibit 1 to the Declaration of Zachary M. Crosner in support of
6 Plaintiff's unopposed Motion for Preliminary Approval of Class Action Settlement, filed on or
7 about March 10, 2023, is within the range of possible recovery and, subject to further
8 consideration at the Final Approval Hearing described below, is preliminarily approved as fair,
9 reasonable, and adequate;

10 2 For purposes of settlement only, the Court provisionally and conditionally certifies
11 the following class: "All current and former hourly non-exempt employees employed by
12 Defendant Kyo Autism Therapy, LLC ("Kyo") in the State of California from November 10, 2017
13 through January 1, 2023."

14 3. The Court finds the Settlement Class, consisting of approximately 2,383 members,
15 is so numerous that joinder of all members is impracticable, and that the Settlement Class is
16 ascertainable by reference to the business records of defendant Kyo.

17 4. The Court finds further there are questions of law and fact common to the entire
18 Settlement Class, which common questions predominate over any individualized questions of law
19 or fact. These common questions include, without limitation: (1) whether Kyo paid Settlement
20 Class Members for all hours worked, (3) whether Kyo provided Settlement Class Members with
21 all required meal and rest periods, or compensation in lieu thereof, (3) whether Kyo properly
22 reimbursed Settlement Class Members for business expenses, and (4) whether Kyo provided
23 Settlement Class Members with proper itemized wage statements.

24 5. The Court finds further the claims of named Plaintiff Liliya Gotishan are typical of
25 the claims of the Settlement Class, and that she will fairly and adequately protect the interests of
26 the Settlement Class. Accordingly, the Court appoints Liliya Gotishan as the Class
27 Representative, and appoints her counsel of record Crosner Legal, P.C. as Class Counsel.

28 6. The Court finds further that certification of the Settlement Class is superior to other

1 available means for the fair and efficient adjudication of the controversy.

2 7. The Court finds further that, in the present case, the proposed method of providing
3 notice of the Settlement to the Settlement Class via First Class U.S. Mail to each Settlement Class
4 Member's last known address, is reasonably calculated to notify the Settlement Class Members of
5 the proposed Settlement and provides the best notice possible under the circumstances. The Court
6 also finds the Notice of Class Action Settlement form is sufficient to inform the Settlement Class
7 Members of the terms of the Settlement and their rights thereunder, including the right to object to
8 the Settlement or any part thereof and the procedure for doing so, their right to exclude themselves
9 from the Settlement and the procedure for doing so, their right to obtain a portion of the
10 Settlement proceeds, and the date, time and location of the Final Approval Hearing. The proposed
11 Notice of Class Action Settlement (Exhibit A to the Settlement Agreement) and the procedure for
12 providing Notice set forth in the Settlement Agreement, are approved by the Court.

13 8. Under the terms of the Settlement Agreement, the Court approves the Parties'
14 selection of Atticus Administration, LLC as the Settlement Administrator. The Settlement
15 Administrator is ordered to mail the Class Notice to the Settlement Class Members via First-Class
16 U.S. Mail as specified in the Settlement Agreement, and to otherwise carry out all other duties set
17 forth in the Settlement Agreement. The Parties are ordered to carry out and comply with all terms
18 of this Order and the Settlement Agreement, and particularly with respect to providing the
19 Settlement Administrator all information necessary to perform its duties under the Settlement
20 Agreement.

21 9. Any member of the Settlement Class who wishes to comment on or object to the
22 Settlement or any term thereof, including any proposed award of attorney's fees and costs to Class
23 Counsel or any proposed representative service award to the Class Representatives, shall have
24 sixty (60) days from the mailing of the Class Notice to submit his or her comments and/or
25 objection to the Settlement Administrator, as set forth in the Settlement Agreement and Class
26 Notice.

27 10. A Final Approval Hearing is hereby set for September 14th 2023, at 9:30 a.m. in
28 Department 302 of the San Francisco County Superior Court, to consider any objections to the

1 Settlement, determine if the proposed Settlement should be found fair, adequate and reasonable
2 and given full and final approval by the Court, and to determine the amount of attorney's fees and
3 costs awarded to Class Counsel, the amount of any representative service award to the Class
4 Representative, the PAGA Payment to the LWDA and PAGA Members, and to approve the fees
5 and costs payable to the Settlement Administrator. All legal memoranda, affidavits, declarations,
6 or other evidence in support of the request for final approval, the award of attorney's fees and
7 costs to Class Counsel, the service award to the Class Representative, PAGA Payment to the
8 LWDA and PAGA Members, and the fees and costs of the Settlement Administrator, shall be filed
9 no later than sixteen (16) court days prior to the Final Approval Hearing. The Court reserves the
10 right to continue the Final Approval Hearing without further notice to the Settlement Class
11 Members.

12 11. Provided he or she has not submitted a timely and valid Request for Exclusion, any
13 Settlement Class Member may appear, personally or through his or her own counsel, and be heard
14 at the Final Approval Hearing regardless of whether he or she has submitted a written objection.


